

Sterilizer Control

The sterilization of dental instruments is a key step in a program to control the transmission of infections. The identification of non-functional sterilization systems is an obligatory measure in view of limiting the risks of cross-contamination. Biological indicators, based on the destruction of bacterial spores, is the only universally recognized system to prove that a sterilization process has been efficient.
